

Who Should Have a Seat at the AI Strategy Table?

To fully measure the viability of an AI solution, the economic impact - including cost reduction and resource utilization - must be measured with the same diligence as patient outcomes. Therefore a multidisciplinary team with experts from various departments should all have a seat at the AI strategy table to ensure ROI goals are all-encompassing.

Clinical Champion(s):

defines use cases and insights on the measurable impact of AI on patient care

Department Leader(s):

reviews resource allocation and change management measures

Executive Champion:

responsible for key performance indicators and ensuring the technology aligns to long-term facility strategies

Information Technology:

expert on technical implementation, integration, data collection and ongoing management

Project Manager:

business or clinical representative responsible for timelines and milestones

Finance:

balances costs with benefits; sets framework for ROI, including baseline values

Quality:

evaluates impact on patient outcomes and quality improvement initiatives

Legal:

ensures compliance with state, federal and regulatory requirements
